



# Homestay Accommodation

Bream Bay College offers the following service to the International Students in Homestay accommodation.

1. All families have been visited and undergone a New Zealand Police Check to ensure the suitability for being a homestay family. These procedures insure the Code of Practice requirements are met.
2. Communication between the homestay family and the student is encouraged prior to the placement of the student if he or she is overseas at the time of application.
3. Good quality, pleasant houses.
4. There is a variety of family structures to choose from eg. An older couple with no children a family with teenagers a younger couple with no children a family with younger children
5. The homestay accommodation will preferably be close to Bream Bay College, in general within walking distance or a short bus ride away.
6. Students will have their own room with desk.
7. Pre-placement inspection of house and family by our International Student Liaison.
8. The International Student Liaison selects homestay families and places students. There is provision to change homestay if either the student or the family is not satisfied.
9. Regular check-up and monitoring of homestay situation.
10. Requirement on homestay parents to monitor and supervise the student, and to set and maintain reasonable standards of behaviour and study.
11. Students will only be required to do chores about the home.
12. At least three meals per day provided.
13. The cost for 2019 is \$260 per week.
