- School Councils. . - Tsunami Response. The evacuation of the staff and students went well, with everyone getting to the top of Finlayson Hill within 10 to 15 minutes, and with plenty of water and shade. However, the decision has been made to change the evacuation site to another down McCathie Road where the ground is flat and where toilets and water will be made available. The school is also putting in place a system where students will be allowed to be released to parents or caregivers.
- The new canopy, Air conditioning units and the recently moved Wellness Centre and Year 13 Common Room are all looking great and nearing completion. The school budget will cover a deck alongside each of the two prefabs <u>IF</u> a builder can be found to build them.
