Principals Report:

- **The 4th term commenced smoothly** with both teachers and students ready immediately to start with their online lessons and no need for extra time to prepare.
- **Kathryn Berkett** presentation postponed until 2022.
- **School Buildings.** The new Year 7 & 8 Block building permits should be through by December, with building predicted to start in February 2022.
- **Wearing Masks** is compulsory on the school buses, however with students omitting to bring them, the school is supplying 50 to 60 masks per day. Parents may be asked to collect their children if it continues into the future.
- If we go into Level 3, principals will decide if students should sit exams or not. **Exams** will be able to go ahead but under very strict conditions, i.e. Students will be separated by desks set 1.5m apart.
- **School swimming pool.** The school has a meeting with Sport Northland on 12 November to discuss its use over the summer holidays. There is a possibility that in conjunction with the Bream Bay Community Trust and the council it will be open for community use and run like the Whangarei Aquatic Centre.
- **Year 10 Projects** may be run over 3 days in the middle of term 4 to include the 3 phases of planning, creating and reflection.
- **End of Year Prize Giving's** will be different again this year, unless in Alert Level 1, and it looks like the different Year Levels might have to be held separately. It may be that no parents will be allowed to attend as it will then make the event a public gathering which has a limit of 100 people indoors. However, subject to student's privacy concerns it could possibly be live streamed.
- The **Leavers' dinner** won't go ahead if still in Level 2.
