Principals Report:

Wayne Buckland

- **Great start to the Term** with the Powhiri Day 1, and Day 2 the students were straight into learning.
- **Student Focus & Possible Parent Evenings.** Term 1 – Alcohol & Driving. Term 2 – Drugs. Term 3 – Mental Wellbeing. Each term there will be a focus for the students on one of the above topics, with speakers coming to the school. Wayne asked if we had any recommendations for appropriate presenters, suggesting options like Rebecca Oaten, aka the Helmet Lady who campaigned to make cycle helmets compulsory in New Zealand & Gillian Archer from Northland Road Safety. The option to acquire Defensive Driving books and information from NZTA might also be suitable. Shaz suggested that one of the Parafed members who might've been a victim or survivor of an accident pertaining to our topics might be a good fit. The school discussions will include topics like Binge drinking of 4 or more alcoholic drinks, the effects of the hallucinogenic drugs like Ecstasy, and the addiction to other drugs like marijuana, cocaine and heroin. While kids' brains are still wiring and developing they are more susceptible to addiction than an adult.
- Bev mentioned topics like **PLEDGING** and having a **GUARDIAN ANGEL** might also be something that could be included in student discussions. Perhaps we could have a tee-shirt & poster competition...
- The school has a new mower, and with Matthew keeping building maintenance/painting under control the college is looking great.
